Despite health and subsequent financial difficulties, their owner desperately tried to hold on to her dogs, but in the end she decided to contact HRI, realizing that it was in her pets' best interest to find new homes for them.

After the Intake Committee decided to accept the four dogs, Diana Brooks, State Contact for Georgia, took charge of the rescue. She secured foster homes for them and organized the pick-up and transfer of the dogs to their new homes. On September 23, Diana met up with Ann Adams and Claudia Ganas to drive to the owner's home where they were greeted by four friendly, excited dogs and a very sad owner. Although she knew she had made the right decision, she was still heart-broken when she said good-bye to her pets.

Thanks to HRI, the "Georgia Four" are enjoying their new foster homes (Pasha lives with Ann, Scarlett Tara and Latte are with Claudia, and Suri is fostered by Joyce Smith), where they receive a better-quality diet, much-needed exercise to lose excess weight, "spa" treatments for skin infections due to flea bites, and

### The Nannies

With the increasing number of dogs being surrendered and fostered within HRI, it became apparent to the Board of Directors that the Dog Wrangler needed assistance in keeping track of the dogs, so the Nanny positions were created to fulfill this need.

There is one Nanny for the Eastern portion of US, one for Central US and one to cover the Western states.

When a new dog enters the HRI fostering system, the Nanny sends a welcome packet to the foster family, complete with a rescue tag, safety protocol, paperwork and vet checklists and valuable fostering information.

The Nanny collects info on each new dog for the HRI database and assists in writing up a bio on each dog to feature on the HRI website, in addition to keeping the Dog Wrangler updated on each dog and his/her progress.

She offers support and guidance to the State Contact and foster parents during the fostering period, assists in searching for the family that best meets the dog's needs and helps finalize the adoptions.

The Nanny is a shoulder to lean on, an ear that listens and a cheerleader all wrapped up in one neat package.
