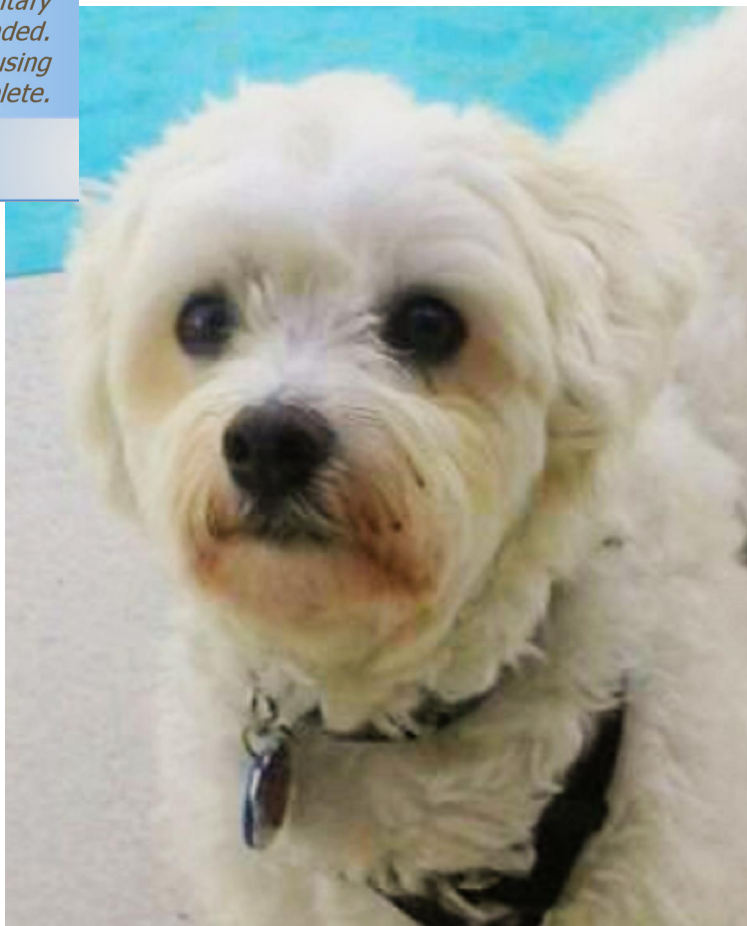
Adoption Corner:
